INSTALLATION - FIELD MANAGER

FULL-TIME POSITION

Field Managers (FM's) will assist Project Managers (PM's) in supervising Assistant Field Managers and Restoration Technicians on a variety of ecological restoration projects. The goal of the FM position is to run projects efficiently as well as develop a team of Restoration Technicians as needed to successfully install ecological restoration projects. FMs will bid and oversee their own projects, as well as implement more complex projects while working with the Project Manager.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Work in conjunction with Project Managers ensuring that installation projects run efficiently
- Oversee on-site crew members in daily operations of installation projects
- Work with Project Managers to communicate to clients
- Conduct all tasks involved with successfully installing small to large scale restoration projects, including but not limited to seeding, planting, erosion control installation and limited equipment operation
- Utilize an ATV, water tanker, or backpack sprayer for herbicide applications involved in site preparation.

- Complete a variety of restoration duties, utilizing various types of equipment, such as small tractors, 3-point implements, hand tools, skid-loaders, ATV/UTVs, mowers, weed whips, chainsaws, powered augers, among other equipment.
- Performs tree shearing skidding or forestry mowing with skid-loader mounted implements
- Maintain work records and associated paperwork, including daily work logs and herbicide treatments
- Performs other duties as assigned

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS

- Must be able to lift up to 50 lbs
- Able to bend, stretch, push, pull, reach and move as needed in order to complete various vegetation management duties
- Prolonged periods of time standing
- Able to work long hours, including early mornings, late evenings and occasional weekends; operating hours may be reduced during the winter season
- Must be able to work in varying weather conditions, including extreme heat and extreme cold

DESIRED QUALIFICATIONS

- 3+ year of experience working in landscaping or agriculture preferred
- 1+ year of supervisory experience
- Bachelor's degree in Ecology, Biology, Wildlife Management, Botany, Environmental Studies, Natural Resources Management or related fields preferred, or an equivalent combination of education and experience
- Experience with the safe operation and general maintenance of tools and equipment, such as pumps, small engines, sprayers, tractors, ATV/UTVs, trailers, mowers and other equipment used in restoration landscaping
- Ability to read and navigate maps, and/or plans, as well as accurately follow directions
- Must have or be willing to acquire within the first 3 months with company assistance, a MNDOT Health Card and USDA Herbicide Applicator License.
- Basic computer knowledge, including proficiency in Microsoft Office Suite preferred
- Strong verbal and written communication skills
