FULL-TIME PERMANENT POSITION

The Land Management Coordinator (LMC) project manages a large variety of ecological restoration management projects, ranging from small raingardens to large scale native restoration sites. The IC also builds and supervises a field team, oversees project logistics and implementation (scheduling), department budgets, and provides a high level of customer service. Projects are located primarily in the Twin Cities area and Upper Midwest.

DESIRED QUALIFICATIONS

- Highly ambitious and motivated: looking to develop and advance their career
- 5 years of ecological restoration experience (installation or land management)
- 2 years supervising/mentoring field crews: restoration techniques, equipment maintenance, safety, etc.
- Demonstrates ability to manage projects, budgets, and logistically complex issues
- Can read and decipher architectural drawings, engineering documents, and maps
- Strong communication skills and experience de-escalating conflict

- Operator experience with heavy machinery (tractor, skid loaders, excavators)
- Prescribed burn experience and/or S/130, S/190 or greater fire training certifications
- Ability to work with culturally diverse populations
- Must possess a clean driving record and valid driver's license (ability to obtain MNDOT Health card)

GENERAL EXPECTATIONS

- Work weeks will be 40-50 hours depending on seasonal workload and weather conditions.
- The position is primarily office based with the opportunity to work outside doing manual labor (<25%)
- Work is conducted in all sorts of extreme weather conditions (rain, snow, heat, cold)
- Weekend work can occur. LANDBRIDGE requires flexibility with scheduling due to workload needs and external challenges (i.e.: weather).
- Workdays will begin and end at LANDBRIDGE central headquarters in Saint Paul, MN
- Salaried position ranging from \$45,000-\$55,000
