PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Deliver customer service (communication, attentiveness to customer needs, teaching, etc.)
- Maintain a clean, organized, and safe work environment

- Maintain a variety of landscaping focused equipment: tractors, tillers, BCS, excavators, bobcats and the like to ensure safe operation for our customers and crews
- Check equipment upon return and ensure any damage is repaired and the equipment is running properly
- Order parts for equipment to repair and maintain
- Follow and maintain with others proper safety procedures
- Assist with tracking and reconciling inventory

ADDITIONAL RESPONSIBILITIES

- Build customer relationships for equipment repairs and also rentals and sales
- Assist with executing the rental process, including opening and closing of rental contracts, determining total charges, helping load equipment, and inspecting equipment upon return

GENERAL EXPECTATIONS

- Work weeks will be 30-40 hours depending on workload, less in the slower months
- Work is conducted in two locations as repairs are needed. A company vehicle is provided for transportation between locations after reporting to our Somerset location
- Lifting up to 75 lbs
