In addition, the Ops Manager is responsible for the daily review and implementation of operations systems throughout the organization including hiring, accountability, monitoring AR, crew safety and oversight with equipment and fleet management

ensuring crews and coordinators have what they need to get field work accomplished in an efficient and profitable manner.
